### **HWY 90A Intersection at Lane Drive Reopening**

Stalled construction since 2017 raised safety concerns for community

**FORT BEND COUNTY, TX** – Hwy 90A near Lane Drive will be restored to its previous configuration for full use by the end of the week. The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) removed concrete barricades and barrels that have been blocking lanes of traffic since 2017. TxDOT is wrapping up restriping the streets and reconfigured the traffic lights to ensure safe traffic flow, similar to what was seen before the start of the project in 2017.

Since coming to office, Commissioner Dexter L. McCoy worked diligently with local officials and TxDOT offices to safely open the lanes and intersections for frustrated residents. An effort that required several meetings with the TxDOT area office as well as the Houston district office, and an offering of county resources to expedite the work.

“We are thankful for the residents who spoke up about their safety concerns in this area, and we are grateful to TxDOT who heard us when we relayed these concerns. We will continue working closely with TxDOT and the community once this project is truly ready to move forward,” said Commissioner McCoy.

Fort Bend County is home to nearly 900,000 people and is one of the fastest growing counties and most ethnically diverse counties in the United States. Commissioner McCoy took office in 2023 to serve Fort Bend Precinct 4’s nearly 250,000 residents.
