Fort Bend County Judge KP George's Statement Regarding the Lockdown of Lamar CISD Campus - George Ranch High School

(FORT BEND, TX) – Today, the collective and swift actions of Lamar Consolidated ISD, our Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office, local and campus law enforcement officers, and our Fort Bend County Office of Emergency Management & Homeland Security, serve as an indication that we are prepared to respond to critical incidents that may occur at our school campuses.

Law enforcement officials on the scene were quickly able to determine that there was no active, credible threat. We will continue to work together to ensure the safety and well-being of our students, teachers, families, and communities in Fort Bend County.
