PRESS RELEASE****Fort Bend County Showcases Flood Camera Network and Emergency Preparedness Upgrades at Press Conference**

FORT BEND COUNTY, TX – Fort Bend County Judge KP George held a press conference yesterday to highlight critical advancements in hurricane preparedness and flood response, just as the region enters the height of hurricane season.

Hosted in front of the newly unveiled Remote Command Center vehicle at the Emergency Operations Center, the event featured remarks from Fort Bend County Judge KP George, Emergency Management officials, and Precinct 3 County Commissioner Meyers.

The press conference featured the county's new Flood Camera Network, which provides real-time visuals of high-risk areas to support faster response during severe weather events. These tools help emergency teams better assess conditions on the ground and alert the public to hazards more effectively.

"The safety and well-being of our residents is always top of mind," said Judge George. "These are game-changing tools—not just for our response teams, but for the safety and peace of mind of every family in our community."

The event also featured the debut of the County's newly wrapped Remote Command Center. This mobile unit will be deployed during major disasters to maintain communication, coordination, and leadership in the field.
