**Fort Bend County Hosts Emergency Management Tabletop Exercise to Bolster  
Disaster Readiness**

**FORT BEND COUNTY, TX** – Fort Bend County Judge KP George joined municipal officials and emergency management coordinators from across the county today for a tabletop exercise aimed at improving coordination and response in the face of future disasters.

Held at the Fort Bend County Emergency Operations Center, the training session focused on enhancing multi-agency communication and clarifying operational procedures. Topics included the distinction between jurisdiction-specific emergency calls and Multi-Agency Coordination (MAC) Group meetings, as well as refining Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) to streamline disaster financial reimbursements.

“When I first ran for County Judge, emergency management was one of my top priorities, and it still is today,” said Judge George. “Our goal is always to be proactive, not reactive. Today’s session is proof that we are putting that principle into action.”

The Judge emphasized that coordination and communication are key to ensuring Fort Bend County remains ready, responsive, and resilient during emergency events.
