Fort Bend County Judge KP George's Statement on U.S. Supreme Court Overturning Roe v. Wade

(FORT BEND, TX) - This country, which I love, has long been the symbol of freedom for so many. People, like myself, come to this country because they are able to pursue the "American Dream", freely express themselves, and make choices according to the principles and values that they hold close. However, our democracy is under attack.

The common belief in liberty, justice, and the pursuit of happiness has been put in jeopardy. The only way that our country, based on the foundations of freedom, democracy, and justice, will prevail is if we speak out against those who embrace anti-democratic ideals and use women's rights to make political statements.
