WHAT:

Fort Bend County offers **daytime and overnight warming centers** in response to cold weather conditions, providing residents with a safe place to stay warm.

WHERE & WHEN:

Daytime Warming Centers – Open during regular business hours

All 12 Fort Bend County Library locations

Fort Bend Family YMCA (Missouri City)

Overnight Warming Center – Open from **8 p.m. to 8 a.m.**

Attack Poverty – Friends of North Rosenberg

Capacity: **30 people** (Additional space may be opened if needed)

ADDITIONAL DETAILS:

- **Pets:** Only **service animals** are allowed at the warming center. No accommodations for pets are available.
- **Resources Available:** This **warming center**, with limited resources, provides a safe, warm place to stay.
- **Transportation:** Fort Bend County **Public Transportation** may be an option for residents needing transportation. Call **866-751-TRIP** (Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m.) for scheduled ride services.
