## Fort Bend County's Countdown - 2025 Hurricane Season

- WHO: Fort Bend County Judge KP George Greg Babst, Fort Bend County Office of Homeland Security & Emergency Management Lee Vela, Clear Channel Outdoor
- WHAT: The launch of the 2025 hurricane preparedness campaign featuring a virtual countdown clock on area digital billboards.
- WHEN: Wednesday, May 7, 2025<u>, at 9</u>:00 a.m.
- WHERE: South Main Service Station 3311 Main Stafford, Texas
- WHY: In partnership with Clear Channel Outdoor, Fort Bend County is launching its 2025 hurricane preparedness campaign. As part of this effort, 10 digital billboards provided at no cost to the County—will feature a live countdown to the official start of hurricane season.

These public service messages are designed to raise awareness and encourage residents to take steps to prepare before a storm strikes. Beginning June 1, the billboard messages will shift to seasonal hurricane safety and preparedness reminders through November 30.
