Suspect Wanted for Burglary of a Habitation

(FORT BEND COUNTY, TX) – The Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office (FBCSO) is currently working with the Gulf Coast Violent Offenders Task Force to locate Jaime Ediel Buentello, 33, for Burglary of a Habitation.

On May 19th, 2024, FBCSO conducted a Burglary of Habitation investigation in the 7300 block of Powerline Road in Richmond, Fort Bend County, Texas. Through this investigation, a suspect was identified as Jaime Ediel Buentello of Rosenberg, Texas.

An arrest warrant for Buentello was issued on May 19th, 2024, for Burglary of Habitation (Intent to Commit Assault) with a set bond amount of \$150,000.

The Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office is not investigating any threats to Lamar Consolidated Schools related to this incident. Threats to Lamar Consolidated Schools, staff and/or students were not revealed throughout this investigation.
