Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office Investigating Homicide, Seeking Vehicle of Interest

(FORT BEND COUNTY, TX) – The Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office (FBCSO) is actively investigating a homicide that occurred in the 10500 block of State Highway 6 South, in Sugar Land, Fort Bend County, Texas.

On Saturday, June 21, 2025, at approximately 11:51 a.m., deputies responded to a report of a white Toyota Camry that had left the roadway and crashed into a ditch along the southbound lanes of State Highway 6 South. Upon arrival, deputies located the driver, identified as 43-year-old Roy Ferrer, who was found deceased from a single gunshot wound to the head. Preliminary findings from the investigation indicate that road rage may have been a contributing factor in the shooting incident.

As part of the ongoing investigation, surveillance video captured what is believed to be a vehicle of interest. The vehicle is described as a gray 2013 – 2019 Nissan Sentra with dark-tinted windows (**see attached photo**).

“This case is a top priority for our agency,” said Sheriff Eric Fagan. “Our investigators are working tirelessly to piece together every detail of this case and pursue those responsible for this senseless act. We are asking the public to assist us by sharing any information that may help identify the vehicle or individuals involved. Your cooperation could make a critical difference.”

The investigation remains active and ongoing.
